LEGAL NOTICE TO AURORA ELECTION COMMISSION ELDERLY AND DISABLED VOTERS

Please be advised that the following voting aids are available to assist the elderly and disabled voters in Aurora Election Commission jurisdiction for the General Primary Election on March 20, 2018.

VOTER REGISTRATION	Registrars are available at municipal and township offices, as well as other locations in the Aurora Election Commission jurisdiction. Call 630-897-4030 for the Registrar nearest to you.
PERMANENTLY DISABLED VOTE BY MAIL PROGRAM	Allows permanently disabled voters the ability to have a ballot automatically mailed to them for five years. Call 630-897-4030 for more information.
VOTE BY MAIL	Request not more than 90 days or less than 5 days prior to the Election. Visit our website at auroravotes.org or call 630-897-4030 for more information.
SAME DAY REGISTRATION	Now available at your Polling Place on Election Day. Voters must be able to provide two forms of identification; one must list the voter's current address.
VOTING ASSISTANCE	Elderly and disabled voters requiring assistance may be helped by a friend, a relative, or two Election Judges (one from each political party) at the Polling Place. (Affidavit is Required)
CURBSIDE VOTING	Available for voters that are physically unable to enter the Polling Place. Call the Aurora Election Commission at 630-897-4030 for information. (Affidavit is Required)
AutoMARK VOTER ASSIST TERMINAL	Optical scan ballot-marking technology system that allows voters to mark a ballot privately and independently. (No Affidavit is Required)
ACCESSIBLE VOTING BOOTH	Every Polling Place will have a wheelchair accessible voting booth.
HAND-HELD MAGNIFIER	Used to view the ballot in a larger format.

The last day to register to vote (except online) for the March 20, 2018 Primary Election is **February 20, 2018**.
The last day to register to vote ONLINE for the March 20, 2018 Primary Election is **March 4, 2018**.
